Effective as of Tuesday, March 17, 2020 (immediately), in accordance with Emergency Order #5 issued by WI Governor Tony Evers, a statewide moratorium on mass gatherings of 10 people or more has been established to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

The Trinity Lutheran Church Council met at 10:00 a.m. today to consider the church's response to the Governor's Emergency Order.

The following items were discussed and acted upon by the Church Council, and are hereby effective immediately:

- All regular church services, Bible Study, and any fellowship activities are hereby canceled until further notice. Please note that originally Bible Study was to continue, but upon further discussion it was also canceled.
- A weekly recorded service by Pastor Senn (with **no** congregation present) will be made available via Trinity Lutheran's Facebook Page, YouTube, and linked also on our Trinity Website (www.trinitybeloit.org) This service will be available for viewing starting every weekend.
- The Lord's Supper with Individual Cup will be offered to a group of no more than 8 people at a time weekly on the following days and times. Each session will last approximately 15-20 minutes. These times may be adjusted as needs arise.
 - Mondays at 10:00 and 10:45 a.m.
 - Tuesdays at 3:00 p.m. and 3:45 p.m.
 - Wednesday at 6:30 p.m. and 7:15 p.m.
 - Thursdays at 6:30 p.m. and 7:15 p.m.
 - **NOTE: You must call the office (362-3607) M-Th mornings or email (trinity@trinitybeloit.org) to schedule your time. Once we reach 8 members, then the session is at capacity.**
- If the above mentioned sessions do not work, please feel free to contact Pastor Senn (608-436-1355) or e-mail him at baldingpastor@gmail.com to schedule an individual communion session.
- The office will weekly e-mail and/or mail the sermon and announcement page. If you have not provided the office an e-mail address, PLEASE let us know since e-mail is much less expensive than the cost of U.S. Mail.
- The Council wants to remind all parishioners that the church will continue to incur expenses and salaries. Please continue your stewardship, if possible, by mailing or dropping off your envelopes to the office during M-Th office hours (best time is 9:00 – 11:00 a.m.)

Pastor Senn will remain available throughout the period of this emergency to provide pastoral services when/if needed on an individual basis. Please feel free to contact him at any time at his e-mail address or phone number above.
